WCI's Technical Steering Committee (TSC) seeks Technical Workgroup (WG) Members.

Technical Workgroups

WCI's Technical Steering Committee (TSC) has established Workgroups (WG), with each WG responsible for a particular portfolio of technology. WG Members are responsible for ensuring that WG work products meet the requirements of WCI, its stakeholders, and the marketplace.

Four WGs have been established by TSC:

1. Communications WG: Specifications and tools in support of certifying the ISA100.11a standard itself.
2. Profiles WG: Specifications and tools in support of certifying WCI profiles, including Temperature, Pressure, Positioner, HART Adapter, and other device types as the marketplace requires in the future. Device descriptions and capability files are also within the scope of the Profiles WG.
3. Gateway WG: Specifications and tools in support of certifying high-side gateway interfaces, initially focused on an interoperable General Client Interface.
4. Provisioning WG: Specifications and tools in support of provisioning. Initially focused on certification of an interoperable infrared interface.

Workgroup Member Responsibilities and Commitment

WG Members will participate in review of draft specifications that will be circulated periodically by Workgroup leadership. WG Members will also be invited to teleconferences and meetings that will be scheduled by WG leadership as needed.

Occasionally, a WG will distribute technical material to its members for review. All WG members are encouraged participate in these reviews. It is understood that some members need to limit their participation to technical reviews.

In addition, some WG members will be needed as volunteers for more extensive WG involvement, such as WG leadership, editing, and project delivery.

A WCI member company may have multiple representatives in a WG, but only one individual per company may be designated as a primary member contact. Primary members are responsible for casting votes for their represented company.

No drafts, work or proceedings from any WG shall be disclosed to an outside third party or any other WCI member. Distribution of draft specifications beyond WG members is a TSC function, not a WG function.
